Leave was granted to the Harford County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 1 and 2, of chapter 490, passed at the January Session of 1890, entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article 13, of the Code of Public Local Laws of this State, title "Harford County," sub-title "Wild Fowl."

Leave was granted to the Baltimore City Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to provide for an equitable adjustment between vendor and vendee, in cases of default, where sales of personalty are made on the installment plan in Baltimore city.
