Leave was granted to the Committee on Agriculture to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal and amend section 49, of Article 25, of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, sub-title "Draining Land."

On motion of Mr. Sams,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled an Act to establish a Board of Gas and Electric Light Commissioners.

On motion of Mr. Wilkinson,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Claims to introduce a bill entitled an Act to refund to the Pocomoke Bridge Company, a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of Maryland, the main office of said company being in Pocomoke city, Worcester county, the sum of one hundred and sixty-one dollars and eighty-five cents, taxes paid in error into the State Treasury.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Claims to introduce a bill entitled an Act to refund to Robert J. Henry, of Worcester county, the sum of seventeen dollars and sixty-seven cents, taxes paid in error into the State Treasury.
