

Senate bill entitled an Act to grant the sanction and consent of the General Assembly of Maryland to the sale by Wm. J. Hiss and other trustees, of a lot of ground in Baltimore city, and the annual rent issuing therefrom, to St. Paul's Evangelical Lutheran Church of Baltimore city.

Was read a third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follows:
