

Senate bill entitled an Act to amend Article 66, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Mortgages," by adding thereto an additional section to be numbered and designated as section 24.

Was read a third time, and passed by yeas and nays, as follows:

House bill entitled an Act to amend Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Corporations," sub-title "Turnpike, Plank Road and Passenger Railway Companies," by adding a new section thereto, to be known as 236 A.

Was read a third time, and passed a by yeas and nays, as follows:
