Sec. 7. And be it enacted, That on the construction of said road, and the repairs of the road bed between the tracks, the same shall be done under the supervision and direction of the County Commi sioners of Baltimore county, where the road lies in said county, and under the supervision and direction of the City Commissioners of Baltimore city, where the road lies in said city.

Sec. 8. And be it enacted that this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

Which was adopted.

Said bill as amended, was then read a second time, and ordered engrossed for a third reading.

Also, reported favorably, from same Committee,

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," sub-title "Insurance Department," to be known as section 143.

Which was read a second time, and ordered engrossed for a third reading.

Also, reported favorably, from same Committee.

Senate bill entitled an Act to amend the charter of the Writing Telegraph Company of Baltimore city, a corporation heretofore formed in the city of Baltimore, under the provisions of the general corporation law of this State.
