Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 51, of Article 6, of the Code of Public Local Laws, tit'e "Caroline County," sub title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add four new sections hereunto, to be called section 51 A, section 51 B, section 51 C, section 51 D.
