Leave was granted to the Calvert County Delegation and Mr. Combs to introduce a bill entitled an Act to regulate the purchase and sale of certain products in Calvert county, titled "Huckstering."

Leave was granted to the Baltimore County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to prevent the sale of fermented or spirituous liquors or lager beer within a radius of one mile and a half from the station of the Northern Central Railway at Moakton, in Baltimore county.

Leave was granted to the Queen Anne and Kent County Delegations to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal section 212, of Article 18, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Queen Anne's County," sub-title "Oysters," as re-enacted with amendments by the Acts of the General Assembly of 1890, chapter 333.

Leave was granted to the Frederick County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Walkersville, in Frederick county, Maryland.

Leave was granted to the Harford County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 59, 61, and 63, of Article 13, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Harford County," sub title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
