Also, reported favorably, with proposed amendment,

Joint Resolution requiring the president and chief officer of every Savings Bank in this State, and every incorporated institution in this State which receives deposits and compounds the interest and dividends, to report to the Comptroller on or before the first day of July 1892.

AMENDMENTS PROPOSED.

Strike out all after the words "Joint Resolution" and insert the following in lieu thereof:

"Be it resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the president or chief officers of every Savings Bank in this State, and every incorporated institution in this State, which receives deposits and compounds the interest and dividends thereon, as they become due, shall make a report in writing to the Comptroller, on or before the first day of July, 1892, of all deposits made in such Savings Bank or institution, of more than six years standing, and uncalled for and unclaimed; stating in said report the name or names of the person or persons, with last postoffice address, to whose credit said deposits stand on the books of such Savings Bank or institution, and the respective amounts of such deposits, and the date of the last deposit made to such account, and shall also, at the same time, make a report to the Comptroller of all dividends or deposits which have been of more than six years standing and unclaimed and uncalled for, together with the amounts thereof and the names of the parties to whose credit they stand on the books of such Savings Bank or incorporated institution.
