AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid; That the said foregoing sections hereby proposed as an amendment to the Constitution, shall be at the next general election held in this State, submitted to the legal and qualified voters thereof for their adoption or rejection, in pursuance of the direction contained in Article 14 of the Constitution of this State, and at the said general election the vote on said proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be by ballot, and upon each ballot there shall be written or printed the words "For the Constitutional Amendment," or "Against the Constitutional Amendment," as the voter shall elect, and immediately after said election due return shall be made to the Governor of the
