Strike out all after the word "same," in line 29, section 2, down to the word "merchants," inclusive, in line 31.

Mr. Miles submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

After the word "same," in line 29, insert:

"Nor to hermetically sealed goods in the hands of the manufacturers or their agents."

Which was rejected.

Mr. Field submitted the following proposed amendment:

AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

At the end of section 2, add the following: "And all Acts, either general or local, heretofore passed, whereby exemption from taxation are granted or authorized on abatements from assured values of property are authorized or allowed, different from or in excess of the exemptions specially enumerated in this section, are hereby repealed; it being the intent of this Act that no property of any kind or description shall be exempt from the property especially enumerated in this section."
