

In line 21, section 5, after the word "required," insert the words "not exceeding fifty-six thousand dollars."

In section 5, strike out all after the words "county paper." in line 22, and the word "levied" in line 23, and insert the words "that is to say, the excess of such paper over and above the amount of taxes levied therefor, but remaining uncollected."

In section 5, after the words "county thereafter," in line 29, strike out all the remainder of section.

In section 7, line 5, next after the word "warrants," insert the words "relating to the affairs of said county."

In section 8, line 60, strike out "issued" and insert "as issued" for "issue."

Strike out the words "and State" in line 11.

In line 11, insert after the word "county" and before the word "municipal," the word "and."

On motion of Mr. Hill,
