Senate bill entitled an act to repeal section 607, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables," and to repeal chapter 125 of the Laws of 1890, and to re enact with amendment, section 607, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables."

Senate bill entitled an Act to change the title of Article 70 of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, entitled "Official Oaths," to that of "Official and Other Oaths," and to add new section thereto.

Senate bill entitled an Act to prohibit pool selling, book making, or betting in Prince George's and Montgomery county.

Which was read a first time, and referred to Prince George's County Delegation.

#### REPORTS OF STANDING COMMITTEES.
