Chapter 104. An Act to add an additional section to Article 10 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," to be called section 321, regulating the pay of witnesses.

Chapter 105. An act to repeal section 337, of Article 8, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Cecil County," sub title "State's Attorney," and re enact the same with amendments.

Chapter 106. An Act to refund to Ross Compton late collector of taxes for Garrett county, the amount overpaid by him into the State Treasury in 1888 and 1889.

Chapter 108. An Act to appoint two additional police officers in Brooklyn and South Baltimore, Anne Arundel county.

Chapter 112. An Act to confirm Ordinance No. 23, approved April 8th, 1891, of the ordinances of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, entitled "An ordinance to authorize the construction of city passage railway tracks by the North Avenue Railway Company of Baltimore city, on North avenue, from McCullough street to Guilford avenue, and thence on Guilford avenue and North street, to Lexington street. and thence on Lexington street to Charles street, and on North street to the north side of Fayette street.

Chapter 113. An Act to authorize and empower trustees therein named to convey a lot of ground situated in New Market District, in Dorchester county, to the Board of School Commissioners of said county.

Chapter 114. An Act to refund to John H. Giles, late collector of State taxes for the Second Collection District of Somerset county, certain moneys paid by him into the Treasury of the State.

Chapter 116. An Act to repeal section 573, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Baltimore City," sub-title "Jail."

Chapter 117. An Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Harford county to grant a pension to Bridget O'Donnell, widow of Matthew O'Donnell, of said county.

Chapter 118. An Act to sanction the devise by Sarah Ann Taylor, late of Charles county, of certain real estate, to the Vestry of Durham Parish of Protestant Episcopal Church of said county.
