Also,

House bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled 'City of Baltimore.' sub-title 'Courts,' to be known as 'Section 173 A,' providing for the practice in certain cases in Baltimore City Court.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to refund to Wm. A. Lyon, collector of taxes in the 7th Election District of St. Mary's county, a sum of money paid by him into the Treasury of the State.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to enable the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to appropriate money for the relief of the Baltimore Manual Labor School for Indigent Boys.

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 214, of Article 12, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title 'Garrett County,'' sub-title "Sheriff."

House bill entitled an Act to add three additional sections to the Act passed at January Session, 1890, chapter 334, entitled an Act to regulate the sale and granting of licenses for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in Baltimore county.

Severally endorsed: "Read the third time, and passed by yeas and nays."
