Also.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal the fourth section of the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January Session, 1890, chapter 608, entitled an Act to provide for State taxation on the revenue of certain Foreign Corporations, mentioned in this Act, accruing from business done in the State of Maryland, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on Ways and Means.

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, Article 34, entitled "Estrays, Vessels Adrift, Drift Logs," sub-title "Estrays," and 8 A thereof, as enacted by chapter 242, of the Acts of 1890, entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article 34, to 8 A, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.
