House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re enact with amendments section 211, of Article 23, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Corporations," sub-title "Religious Corporations."

House bill entitled an Act to add a section to Article 43, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Health," sub-title "Nuisances," to follow section 38, and to be designated "38 A."
