House bill entitled an Act to correct and make perfect the charter of the Monumental Social Club, of Baltimore city.

Also, favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to add six additional sections to Article 6, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Caroline County," sub-title "County Treasurer," to follow section 68, to be called 68 A, 68 B, 68 C, 68 D, 68 E, and 67 F.

Also, favorably,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 607, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables," and to repeal chapter 125 of the Laws of 1890, and to re-enact with amendment section 607, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Justices of the Peace and Constables."
