Leave was granted to the Committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill entitled an Act to empower the Directors of the Maryland House of Correction to purchase or condemn land and improvements for the extension and enlarging of the lands of said Maryland House of Correction.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 34 A and 34 B, of Article 56, of the Code of Public General Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Licenses," as enacted at the January Session of 1890, chapter 159, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Leave was granted to the Dorchester County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal section 83, of Article 10, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub title "Cambridge," as amended by the Act of 1890, chapter 311 and to re-enact the same with amendments.
