

Mr. Franklin, from a Select Committee, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to add a further supplement to the Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed December Session, 1840, chapter 215, entitled an Act for cleaning out the Pocomoke river by means of a latty, and the supplements thereto, namely: "Act passed at Session, 1845, chapter 321; Act passed at Session of 1846, chapter 361; Act passed at Session of 1858, chapter 178; Act passed at Session of 1860, chapter 196; Act passed at Session of 1862, chapter 110; Act passed at Session of 1868, chapter 84; Act passed at Session of 1878, chapter 436, providing for the appointment of new commissioners and defining their powers and duties."

Which was read a first time.

BILLS—THIRD READING.

House bill entitled an Act to provide for the payment of expenses incurred for the removal of insane or lunatic convicts sent by the State Lunacy Commission from the Maryland Penitentiary, in this State.
