House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 31, of Article 14, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard County," sub-title "Birds and Game."

House bill entitled an Act to carry into effect section 1, of Article 7, of the Constitution of this State, so far as the same relates to Howard county, and to repeal section 39, of Article 14, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Howard County," sub-title "County Commissioners and County Collectors," and to re-enact the same with amendments.
