LEAVES TO INTRODUCE BILLS.

On motion of Mr. Laird,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill entitled an Act to add an additional section to Article 19, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Comptroller," to be known as section 41.

On motion of Mr. Gallagher.

Leave was granted to the Committee on Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 53, of Article 72, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Oysters," sub-title "Packers."

On motion of Mr. Sappington, of Anne Arundel,

Leave was granted to the Anne Arundel County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to add two additional sections to Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Oysters," to be designated as "section 188 A and 188 B."

On motion of Mr. Franklin,

Leave was granted to the Worcester County Delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to submit to the qualified voters of the town of Bishopville, in Worcester county, at an election hereafter to be called, the question as to whether or not sections 60 to 80, inclusive, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Worcester County," sub-title "Bishopville," shall be repealed.

On motion of Mr. Brennan,

Leave was granted to the Baltimore City delegation to introduce a bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, section 410, of Article 4, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "City of Baltimore," sub-title "Houses of Refuge and Reformation."
