On motion of Mr. Gallagher,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Corporations to introduce a bill entitled an Act to regulate Insurance Companies.

On motion of Mr. Bryan,

Leave was granted to the Committee on Temperance to introduce a bill entitled an Act to enable the qualified voters of the Fifth Election District of Queen Anne's county to determine by ballot whether spirituous or fermented liquors shall be sold in said election district or a license granted for the sale of same.
