Senate bill entitled an Act to add additional sections to Article 15, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Kent County," sub-title "Oysters."

Which was adopted.

Mr. Carter, from the Committee on the Judiciary, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 9, 10 and 12, of Article 13, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Bills of Exchange and Promissory notes, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time.

Mr. Field, from the Committee on Militia, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 5, of Act 65, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Militia," and to enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

Mr. Sams, from the Committee on Education, reported unfavorably,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 6, of Article 77, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Public Education," sub-title "Formation of Boards," and section 18 of the same Article and title, sub-title "Duties of County School Commissioners," so far as the said sections relate to Dorchester county, and to enact the following in lieu thereof: "For Dorchester county."

Mr. Meredith moved to substitute the bill for the unfavorable report.

Which was rejected-

The unfavorable report of the committee was then adopted.

Mr. Fitzgerald, from the Committee on Elections, reported favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments section 166, of Article 33, of the Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, title "Elections," as enacted by the Act of 1890, chapter 538.

Which was read a second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
