House bill entitled an Act to provide for the collection of statistics regarding the mortgage indebtedness secured by liens on agricultural lands in this State, and to provide for the payment of the expenses incurred.

Which was adopted.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to pay Charles Simon, Jr., and Alfred Simon, executors of the last will and testament of John M. Simon, late of Baltimore, deceased, taxes paid by Mrs. Johanna M. Simon in her life time in error.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to prevent the importation and sale of diseased or maimed animals and unwholesome articles of food, and to provide for the inspection thereof.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to repeal section 93, of Article 81, of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Revenue and Taxes," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Also, favorably,

House bill entitled an Act to secure the benefits of and care and medical and surgical treatment to indigent deserving persons of this State and to appropriate a sum of money therefor.

Which were severally read a second time, and ordered engrossed for a third reading.

House bill entitled an Act to prevent and punish fraud in sales of goods, wares and merchandise at public or private sales by itinerant venders and to regulate such sales.
