

House bill entitled an Act to add two new sections to Article 5, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Calvert County," under the sub-title "County Commissioners," regulating the term of office of the County Commissioners of said county, to be designated as "Sections 46 A and 46 B."

House bill entitled an Act to allow the sale of tobacco, cigars, soda or mineral waters, ice or medicines and medicinal remedies on the Sabbath day, commonly called Sunday, in the city of Baltimore.

Were severally read a second time, and ordered engrossed for a third reading.
