House bill entitled an Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments, new section 146, of Article 33, of the Code of Public General Laws, as enacted by the Acts of 1890, chapter 538.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to sanction and make valid a bequest of Nancy Camel, late of Washington county, deceased, to "Manor Church" of the Tunker denomination, and a bequest from said Nancy Camel to the M. E. Church, situated in Sharpsburg, Washington county.

Also, returned,

House bill entitled an Act to incorporate the town of Laytonsville, in Montgomery county.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to appropriate a sum of money for the support of the Co-operative Workers of Baltimore city

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to prevent deception and fraud by owners or agents who may have control of any stallion kept for service by prociaiming or publishing fraudulent or false pedigrees or records, and to protect such owners or agents in the collection of fees for service of such stallions, and to prevent the entering of trotting horses out of their classes.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act to carry into effect section 1, of Article 7, of the Constitution of Maryland, so far as the same relates to Carroll county, and to repeal section 18, of Article 7, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Carroll County," sub-title "County Commissioners," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Also,

House bill entitled an Act authorizing and directing H. Fillmore Lankford, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Somerset county, to refund to George M. France the sum of forty-eight dollars for illegal fines paid by him for alleged violations of the local oyster laws of Somerset county, in the State of Maryland.
