Senate bill entitled an Act to authorize the County Commissioners of Anne Arundel county to borrow money on the credit of the county for the purpose of repairing, enlarging and remodeling the Court House of said county, to issue bonds for the payment of the same and to levy taxes to redeem said bonds.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Anne Arundel County Delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to give the sanction of the Legislature to the gifts, &c., to divers charitable and religious institutions contained in the last will and testament of Edward Power, of Baltimore county, deceased, and to prevent any failure of the testamentary purposes of the said Power by reason of uncertainty or mis-description as to any of the said beneficiaries.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal sections 184 F, 184 I, 184 J and 184 O, of Article 2, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Anne Arundel County," sub-title "Liquor and Intoxicating Drinks," as said sections appear in chapter 568 of the Acts of 1890, and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Which was read a first time, and referred to the Anne Arundel County Delegation.

Also,

Senate bill entitled an Act to repeal section 71, of Article 15, of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Kent County," sub-title "Chestertown," and to re-enact with amendments, so as to read as follows.

Also, delivered,

Senate bill No. 97, proposing to incorporate the Annapolis, Eastport and Bay Ridge Electric Railway and Power Company of Anne Arundel county.
