

Governor and County Commissioners authorized to appoint officers. Montgomery county be and they are respectively hereby authorized and directed to appoint for said new district two justices of the peace, two constables, one registration officer for the registration of voters, and all other officers as they may now be authorized by law to appoint for other election districts in Montgomery county, and also to do whatever else within the scope of their authority may be necessary to carry out the object of this act.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That the registration officer of said new district shall make out and prepare new lists of voters for said new district in the manner now prescribed for by law, which said lists shall be returned to the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for said county, and shall be used for the first time in the November election of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 88.

AN ACT to give the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the devise and bequest of a legacy of one thousand dollars to the First English Lutheran Church of Baltimore, under the last will and testament of Frederick Seyler, deceased, late of the city of Baltimore.

Preamble. Whereas Frederick Seyler, deceased, late of the city of Baltimore, by his last will and testament, recorded in the office of the Register of Wills of the city of Baltimore, in Wills Liber N. H., number twenty seven, folio four hundred and twenty-eight, et cetera, directed Frederick Achey and Thomas O. Sollers, his executors and trustees therein mentioned, on the decease of his wife, Catherine C. Seyler, to
