CHAPTER 90.

AN ACT to incorporate the town of New Market, in Frederick county.

Town of New  
Market SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the citizens of the town of New Market, in Frederick county are a body corporate, the [the] name of the commissioners of the town of New Market, and by that name may have Perpetual  
succession. perpetual succession, sue and be sued, and may have and use a common seal, which they may alter or break at pleasure.

Limits of said  
town. Beginning. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the limits of said town of New Market, for the purpose of taxation as well as for all other purposes, shall be as follows: Beginning for the same at the end of a line drawn due south, and five feet from an elm tree (said tree being at the west end of the said town, and about fifty feet south from the middle of the Baltimore and Frederick Turnpike road), then running first south eleven degrees west, thirty-two perches; second, north eighty-eight degrees east, two hundred and fourteen and seven-tenths perches; third, north two degrees west, sixty-four perches; fourth, south eighty-eight degrees west, two hundred and eleven and three tenths perches; then fifth, south eleven degrees west, thirty-two and one-tenth perches to the place of beginning.
