

tax upon the property, real and personal, within the limits of said town, to such amount as may by them from time to time be deemed necessary to accomplish the purposes aforesaid; provided, however, that the taxes so levied shall not exceed the sum or rate of twenty cents on each one hundred dollars valuation of said assessable property for any one year, which tax shall be collected by a tax collector to be appointed by said commissioners for that purpose, and the taxes so collected shall be paid over by said collector to said commissioners for said town, to be by them expended under the provisions of this act, in such manner as they shall direct.

SEC. 13. *And be it enacted*, That the tax collector by them appointed shall give bond in the penal sum of six hundred dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duty, and shall be vested with same power and authority for the collection of town taxes as the collectors of State and county taxes for Frederick county is now, or may hereafter be by law invested with, and the said Commissioners shall fix the term of office, responsibility and compensation of said tax collector of town taxes.

SEC. 14. *And be it enacted*, That the said Commissioners may, as often as they shall deem it advisable, cause an assessment to be made of all real and personal property within the corporate limits of said town by a person to be appointed and paid by them, which assessment shall not, however, exceed the assessment of the same property for county purposes; provided that if any owner of property within said town shall feel aggrieved by the assessment so made he may appeal to the Board of Commissioners for said town, who are hereby empowered to correct the valuation of his property as they may deem reasonable and just, but not to exceed the assessment for county purposes.

SEC. 15. *And be it enacted*, That the said Commissioners shall not expend nor contract to expend in any one year more than the amount of money receivable from taxes and other sources for that year.

SEC. 16. *And be it enacted*, That the said Commissioners, or a majority of them, shall have power
