CHAPTER 100.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county to levy a sum of money as a pension for Solomon Tate, of said county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Queen Anne's county be and they are hereby authorized, in their discretion, to levy upon the assessable property of said county for the sum of thirty dollars for the year of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, and the same amount for the year of eighteen hundred and seventy-nine, as a pension for Solomon Tate, of said county.
