

Required to make out general indexes for Harford county be and he is hereby authorized and required to make out, in a fair and legible handwriting, general indexes, in the names of both plaintiff or complainant and defendant, to the law and equity dockets in his office from the beginning of said dockets to the passage of this act, and shall be allowed therefor the same compensation as is now allowed by law for making general indexes to land records of the county, in addition to all costs for index record books, to be furnished by said clerk, and to be paid for by the County Commissioners for Harford county.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners of Harford county be and they are hereby directed to pay to the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Harford county whatever sum or sums of money may be found to be due him under the preceding section.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That from and after the passage of this act it shall be the duty of said clerk to enter in said index, in the name of both plaintiff or complainant and defendant, all judgments and decrees thereafter obtained on the day on which said judgments are rendered or decree passed, and also to enter the same when satisfied, for which services he shall be allowed the sum of fifty cents, to be paid for by the parties to the suit respectively as other costs are now paid.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
