CHAPTER 105.

AN ACT granting the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland to the gift, devise and bequest in the last Will of Sarah Heller, late of Washington county, deceased, to the German Reformed Church of Clearspring, Washington county, Maryland.

Preamble. Whereas Sarah Heller, late of Washington county, deceased, by her last will and testament, bearing date the fourteenth day of March, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy-four, and duly admitted to probate and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills of Washington county, did give, bequeath and devise to Rev. W. Goodrich, S. M. Reitzell, S. Seibert, John Cook, G. P. Krouse and Hewit Kroh, "then comprising" the consistory of the German Reformed Church of Clearspring, Washington county, Maryland, and their successors in office, in trust for the German Reformed Church of Clearspring, Washington county, Maryland, the sum of three hundred dollars, "therefore,"

Sanction given. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sanction of the General Assembly of Maryland be and the same is hereby given and declared to the above mentioned gift, bequest and devise of the said Sarah Heller, deceased.

In force. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
