

dian before the Orphans' Court for Wicomico county, and to pay and deliver over to the said Covington S. H. Littleton all his property, real and personal, and money that may be due him on said final account, and take his receipt for the same, which shall be acknowledged and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for said county, and have the same effect as if the same was executed by a person of full age.

Be answerable. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the said Covington S. H. Littleton shall be answerable in law and equity for all liabilities, debts and contracts entered into by him, and may sue and be sued, as if he were a man of full age.

In force. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 10.

AN ACT to provide for the payment of the expenses incurred on the part of the State of Maryland in the adjustment of the boundary line between the States of Maryland and Virginia by arbitration, and to appropriate a sum of money therefor.

Appropriation. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of nine thousand five hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the payment of the expenses on the part of the State of Maryland in the adjustment of the boundary line between the States of Maryland and Virginia by arbitration, and the Comptroller is hereby authorized and directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer for the payment thereof in the following manner, viz.: To Jeremiah S. Black, for services rendered as one of the arbitrators, two thousand five hundred dollars; to Charles J. Jenkins, for like services, two thousand five hundred dollars; to James B. Beck, for like services, two thousand five hundred
