

oath, of his or her receipts and disbursements, if any, as such trustee, and the said court, upon the filing of such petition and account, shall have jurisdiction in the premises, and shall cause notices to be given by publication in one or more of the papers of said city or county, and for such time as the said court may deem proper, giving notice of the filing of such petition, and if no good cause shall be shown to the contrary by the day that may be limited in that behalf in said notice, the said court by its decree shall release and discharge the said trustee from the further execution of said trust, and may pass such order as to costs and impose such terms in other respects, if any, as the nature of the case and equity may require; provided that such discharge shall not release said trustee or his sureties, if any, from liability to any of the cestuique trusts or other persons for passed acts, defaults or omissions of duty. Shall not release.

CHAPTER 108.

AN ACT to add an additional article to the Code of Public Local Laws, to be entitled Garrett county.

SEC. 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new article be, and is hereby added to the Code of Public Local Laws to be entitled Garrett county, and to read as follows, viz.: New article added.

BIRDS.

SEC. 1. It shall not be lawful for any person in Garrett county to shoot, kill or in any way trap or destroy any blue birds, swallows, martins, cat birds, sparrows, wrens, whippowills, or any other insectivorous birds at any season of the year under the penalty of two dollars for each bird so taken, killed or destroyed. Not lawful. Penalty.
