

rest all persons whom they may see violating any of the sections of this act, and take them before the nearest justice of the peace to be dealt with as this act directs.

CIRCUIT COURTS.

9. There shall be two jury and two non-jury regular common law terms of the Circuit Court for Garrett county, to be held at Oakland. The two jury terms shall commence on the first Monday of May and the second Monday of September in each year, and the two non-jury terms shall commence on the first Monday of July and the third Monday of December in each year, and to such of said jury terms jurors shall be summoned and returned in the mode and manner prescribed by law.

Terms of
Circuit Court.

10. There shall be annually six regular chancery terms of said Circuit Court, which shall commence on the following days of each year respectively, viz.: the first Monday of January, the first Monday of March, the first Monday of May, the first Monday of July, the second Monday of September, and the second Monday of November, to which said chancery terms all equity process shall be made returnable respectively, and said chancery court shall be always open for the transaction of business therein.

11. The trial terms of the courts of law shall be the term next succeeding the term to which original process shall be returnable.

12. The judges of said court may pass such rules as may be necessary for facilitating the business of the county, both in law and equity.
