

Meetings. 14. They shall meet on first Monday in January, first Monday in May, and the second Monday of September in each year, and may call special meetings when they, or a majority of them, may think proper.

Classify business. 15. They may classify the business of the court, and designate the meetings at which the several classes of business shall be disposed of.

Per diem and mileage. 16. Each commissioner shall receive two dollars and fifty cents for each days session of the board, and each commissioner living five miles or more from Oakland, shall receive six and one-quarter cents per mile each way, for going and returning from each meeting, for all over five miles, but such mileage shall not be allowed more than once each session.

Clerk shall give bond. 17. The clerk to the County Commissioners shall give bond to the State of Maryland, in the penalty of one thousand dollars, approved by said commissioners, conditioned for the faithful performance of the duties of his office, which bond shall be recorded in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for said county.

Clerk shall take oath. 18. The said clerk shall also before one of said commissioners take and subscribe the following oath: I, —, do swear that as clerk to the County Commissioners of Garrett county, I will honestly and faithfully, to the best of my skill and judgment, execute the duties of said office without fear, affection, prejudice or partiality, so help me God.

Compensat'n. 19. Said clerk shall be entitled to such compensation as shall be fixed by the commissioners, not exceeding four hundred dollars.

Supervisors of roads 20. The commissioners for said county shall direct the supervisors of roads to erect and keep up at the expense of the county, at all public cross-roads and where public roads fork, indexes or finger-boards pointing to the nearest town, mill or other public place to which said road leads, with the names of the places and distances thereto legibly inscribed thereon, and the expense thereof shall be levied as other county charges.
