CHAPTER 12.

AN ACT to regulate the compensation of the Sheriff of Prince George's county for keeping and boarding prisoners in jail.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly Allowance to of Maryland, That the allowance to the sheriff of Prince George's county for keeping and boarding prisoners in jail shall be thirty cents each per day.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That all acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act be and the same are hereby repealed; and that this act shall take effect from the day of its passage.
