

59. The provisions of the foregoing section shall apply only to such person as shall bring goods, wares and merchandise into said county to sell at auction within the limits aforesaid, and to such persons as shall sell at auction goods, wares or merchandise sent into the county for the express purpose of being sold as aforesaid by auction.

60. Any person who shall sell as aforesaid within the limits aforesaid without having previously paid the license herein directed, shall be liable to a penalty of one hundred dollars upon conviction thereof in any court of law.

61. The clerk of the Circuit Court shall be entitled to the same fees and commissions for issuing the license and paying into the treasury the money therefore as for like licenses under the laws of this State.

SHEEP.

62. If any dog shall be seen running sheep in said county any person may kill him, or if any dog shall have been known to worry sheep and information thereof given to the owner thereof, if he does not kill said dog he shall make full compensation for all damage done by it, and any person seeing the dog running at large may kill him.

SHERIFF.

63. The Sheriff of Garrett county shall be entitled to receive the following fees for performing the duties of his office, viz: For boarding each prisoner committed to the county jail, forty cents per day; for serving writ and return, sixty cents; for taking bail bond, one dollar; for empanneling jury, three dollars; for serving Scire facias, including the person summoned, sixty cents; for serving citation, sixty cents; for serving subpoena and return, sixty cents; for summoning appraisers to value goods and chattels taken by attachment, fi. fa. or replevie, each person summoned sixty cents; for each person summoned as a witness in any case or inquisition, sixty cents; for laying attachments in hands of garnishee, each person garnished sixty cents; for serving an execution, twenty-five cents; for each prisoner committed
