

to jail, fifty cents; for each prisoner brought out before the court and returned to jail, fifty cents; and for taking prisoners to the penitentiary the following sums of money, namely: When a single convict is taken, forty dollars; when two together, thirty dollars each; when more than two, twenty dollars each, to be levied as other county charges.

64. He shall receive ten per centum for collecting and paying over officers fees. Fee for collecting.

STOCK FOUND TRESPASSING.

65. No person other than a *bona fide* resident of Garrett county shall drive or cause to be driven upon, or permit any of his horses, hogs, sheep or black cattle to enter any of the lands of any citizen of Garrett county, whether said lands be enclosed or not, without the permission or license of such owner. Resident of county.
Without permission.

66. If any such horses, sheep, hogs or black cattle shall at any time be found running at large upon the land of any person within the limits aforesaid, the owner of the land, his agent, tenant or overseer may consider them as trespassing and any distress then by impounding in an enclosure, and it shall be the duty of the person making such distress to deliver, on oath, over his own name and under date, a description in writing of the horses, hogs, sheep or black cattle distrained, with their natural and artificial marks, within five days after making the distress, to some justice of the peace who shall reside nearest to the place where the distress has been made, and the justice shall file the same among the papers of his office and give a copy thereof under his own signature to the person making the distress, and such person may sell the said horses, hogs, sheep or black cattle, or so many thereof as may be necessary to pay the sum of two dollars on each and every head for each day's trespassing as aforesaid. 67. The person making the distress and selling as aforesaid, shall, before making such sale, give notice of the time and place thereof, by public advertisement set up at three or more public places in the neighborhood where such trespass was made, and Give notice by advertisement.
