## TAXES.

No personal property.

71. Where there is no personal property on any land in Garrett county, from which taxes may be made, the tax collector may, if he shall so elect, instead of selling the land under the provisions of the general laws of this State, sell a sufficient quantity of timber suitable for cord wood, fence rails, hoop poles, shingles, staves, railroad ties, or saw logs, in one parcel growing on the same acre or contiguous acres of the land, to pay such taxes.
