

discharge of his duties as treasurer; and he shall receive and pay away all monies that he shall be directed to receive and pay away by the ordinances of said corporation, and said bond shall be recorded in the office of the clerk of the Circuit Court for Garrett county.

Bond to be recorded

114. All elections shall be held and conducted as shall from time to time be directed by the by-laws of the corporation not inconsistent with this charter.

Elections—how conducted.

115. The burgess shall qualify as directed by section six of article sixty-eight of the Code of Public General Laws. The commissioners and all other officers of said corporation, before entering upon the duties of their respective offices, shall take and subscribe before the burgess the following oath: I, — do solemnly swear that I will faithfully execute the office of — to the best of my knowledge and ability, without favor, affection or partiality, so help me God.

Oath.

116. The burgess and commissioners shall meet for the transaction of corporation business on the first Monday in each month, at seven and a-half o'clock in the evening, and the burgess may call a special meeting whenever in his judgment it is absolutely necessary.

Time of meeting.

117. It shall be the duty of the burgess to preside at all meetings, but if he should be temporarily absent, the commissioners present shall designate one of their number to preside *pro tem.*, and such designation shall be entered upon the journal.

Burgess to preside.

118. The burgess and two commissioners shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, and if the burgess shall be temporarily absent, three commissioners shall constitute such quorum.

Quorum.

119. The burgess and commissioners shall, at their regular meeting in June of each year, appoint a collector of taxes and a town clerk, each to serve for one year from the date of his appointment and until his successor is elected and qualified, and the said collector of taxes shall act as town constable.

Appoint collector and clerk.

120. The burgess and commissioners shall make the annual levy of taxes at their regular meeting in

Levy annually.
