before them consistent and in conformity with the corporate powers of said company, and until the next election of officers, the board of directors and other officers of said company shall remain as at present constituted.

Sec. 5. And be it enacted, That so much of the aforesaid act of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, and of the preceeding acts of assembly relating to the chartering and incorporating of said Railroad Company, and the exercise of the powers, rights, Repealed. privileges and duties conferred on or granted to it as may be inconsistent or at variance with the terms and provisions of the two preceeding sections, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 6. And be it enacted, That this act shall take In force. effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 110.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Allegany county to investigate the claim of William H. Moore, and levy and pay him such sum as they may find to be just.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Commissioners of Allegany county be and are hereby authorized and directed to investigate the claim of William H. Directed to Moore against said county, being an assigned claim claim. of William Armstrong for services as clerk to an officer of registration, and to levy and pay to said William H. Moore such sum of money, if any, as they may find to be equitably due on said claim.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.
