

CHAPTER 112.

AN ACT for the better protection of fish in the waters of Frederick and Carroll counties.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to take, catch or destroy any fish in the waters of Frederick or Carroll counties, except with hook and line, or by use of the dip net; provided, that the Potomac river shall be exempted from the provisions of this act. Shall be unlawful.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That any one violating the provisions of the preceding section shall, upon conviction before a justice of the peace of said counties, be liable to a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than ten dollars for each offense, and upon failing to pay said fine and the cost of prosecution, shall be sentenced to imprisonment in the county jail of the county in which the offence has been committed, for a period not exceeding ten days; said fine to be paid to the county commissioners for the use of the county. Penalty.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage, and remain in force for two years. In force.
