

paving and repairing of the gutters and sewers within the corporate limits of said town, and to enforce their orders and enactments in regard thereto by the imposition of fines and penalties.

SEC. —. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take In force. effect from and after the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 119.

AN ACT to incorporate a company to make a turnpike road from Unionville, in Frederick county, to intersect the Unionbridge turnpike road, at or near the dwelling house of Daniel Wolf, in the same county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Stephen Haines, Abram Stoner, Peter Shriver, John Clemson, Oliver H. Pearre, Henry C. Gaither, Charles A. Lawrence and Edward D. Danner, be, and they are hereby appointed Commissioners, who, or a majority of whom, shall cause books to be opened at Unionville, in Frederick county, at such time and place as they, or a majority of them, may deem advisable, for the purpose of receiving subscriptions to the capital stock of the company incorporated by this act, notice having been first given, as the said commissioners, or a majority of them, may deem expedient, of the time and place of opening said books, and continue the same open from time to time, so long and as often as they, or a majority of them, may find necessary to complete such subscriptions.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the capital stock of said company shall be twenty thousand dollars, in shares of twenty-five dollars each, and all individuals and bodies corporate, including the County
