

line to the centre of the stone bridge across Carroll creek on the Baltimore turnpike, then southwardly by a straight line to the northeast corner of the farm of John Loats, thence westwardly by and with the northern boundary line of said John Loats' farm to the eastern boundary line of the Frederick and Georgetown turnpike, thence southwardly by and with the eastern boundary line of said turnpike, it being also the western boundary line of said farm of said John Loats, to a point due east of the southeast corner of Mount Olivet Cemetery, thence by a straight line due west four hundred feet, thence by a straight line northwardly and parallel to the western boundary line of South Market street to the northern boundary line of the farm of Mrs. Wright, now in the possession of L. Mullinix, thence westwardly by a straight line, passing through the southeast corner of Pampell's foundry lot to the Jefferson turnpike or ward, thence westwardly by a straight line to the store-house of John Jifford, on the Middletown turnpike, thence by and with a straight line northeastwardly to the southwest corner of the German Reformed grave-yard, thence northwardly by a straight line parallel to the western boundary line of Bentz street till the northern boundary line of Eight street prolonged westwardly is intersected, thence eastwardly by and with the northern boundary line of Eight street prolonged westwardly to the place of beginning; and the said Mayor and Aldermen and Common Council of Frederick shall have full power and authority to assess, levy and collect within said limits any and all taxes whatsoever which they were authorized to assess, levy and collect within the taxable limits as existing before the passage of this act.
