

CHAPTER 129.

AN ACT to amend article twenty of Public Local Laws, title "Talbot County," sub-title "Trappe," by adding additional sections thereto.

SECTION 1. *And be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That article twenty, of the Code of Public Local Laws, incorporating the town of Trappe, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following additional sections : Article XX amended.

SEC. 205. A. The said commissioners, or a majority of them, are hereby empowered to pass all such by-laws and ordinances as may seem to them necessary for the good government of said town; for the proper and thorough drainage thereof under such ordinances and rules as the said commissioners or a majority of them may adopt; for the removal of all nuisances and obstructions in the streets; for repairing, paving and otherwise improving the streets and alleys of the town; and when in their opinion it may be necessary to open new streets or widen the existing ones, the question shall be then submitted to the taxable citizens of said town, and if approved by a majority vote of said commissioners are authorized to assess the damages and benefits, and execute the work. Empowered to pass
Proper and thorough drainage.
Repair streets, &c.
Submitted to taxable citizens.

SEC. 205. B. *And be it enacted,* That if any person or persons shall violate any of the ordinances of the town of Trappe, under the charter of said town, by loud or boisterous talking, cursing, swearing or using profane or vulgar language, or otherwise, in any manner whatever, disturb the peace and good order of said town, or shall obstruct the streets or sidewalks in any manner, it shall be lawful, and it is hereby made the duty of the bailiff of said town or the sheriff or constable or other municipal officers of Talbot county, to arrest the person or persons so offending or violating any of the ordinances of the town, and take them before some justice of the peace for Talbot county, and upon conviction of said offence or offences, the said offender or offenders shall be fined not less than fifty cents or more than Shall violate.
Profane or vulgar language.
Duty of bailiff.
Shall be fined.
