from side to side, and running back from the river as far as necessary, to completely fill up said dock.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this act shall take In force. effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 20.

AN ACT to repeal an act of the General Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and seventy-six. chapter sixty-two, entitled "An act to prevent the increase of gates upon the public roads of Calvert county."

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the act of the General Assembly of Maryland of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, Repealed. chapter sixty-two, entitled "An act to prevent the increase of gates on the public roads of Calvert county," be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 21.

AN ACT assigning the interest of the State of Maryland in certain personal assets of Cyntice Cannon, a deceased intestate, born out of wedlock unto Catherine M. Cannon, of Dorchester county.

Whereas Cyntice Cannon, late of Dorchester county, deceased, departed this life intestate, unmarried and without children, and without leaving any brother or sister, or descendant of any brother Preamble. or sister, and entitled to the sum of one hundred and twenty-four dollars and eighteen cents, under the distribution made by the Orphans' Court for said county, of the proceeds of the sale of the lands of
