

pens to be at the time of the acknowledgment," or before any justice of the peace or Judge of the Orphans' Court of the county or city in which the vendor resides. And if acknowledged before a justice of the peace out of the county or city in which the vendor resides, the "official character" of said justice shall be certified by the Clerk of the Circuit Court of the county in which said acknowledgment is made, or by the Clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore city if acknowledged in said city.

Official character of justice certified.

In force. SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 140.

AN ACT to provide for the appointment of an additional justice of the peace for election district number three in Harford county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Governor be and he is hereby authorized and empowered to appoint an additional justice of the peace for election district number three in Harford county.

Governor authorized to appoint additional justice of peace.

In force. SECTION 2. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
