ditional compensation shall be allowed as aforesaid, compensat'on  
when the appearance fees allowed, by law, to said  
State's Attorney, amount to or exceed, in any year,  
the sum of nine hundred dollars, nor when such ad-  
ditional compensation, together with said fees, will  
exceed the sum of eight hundred dollars.

SEC. 3. *Be it enacted*, That the State's Attorney Not receive  
for Charles county shall in no case receive fee or unless pres'nt  
compensation when he is not personally present, or  
represented by other counsel acting in the trial of  
such case.

SEC. 4. *Be it enacted*, That the several fees and When due  
allowances provided by the preceding sections, to be and payable.  
paid to the State's Attorney, shall be due and pay-  
able to him in current money by the County Com-  
missioners at their first meeting held after the ad-  
journalment of the respective terms of court at which  
the services were rendered.

SEC. 5. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take In force.  
effect from the date of its passage.
